Inter-zone Parent Handout U14 to U18

Welcome to the REZYSA Inter-zone 2011-2012 Indoor season. This guide provides you with a brief overview of the upcoming season.

Important Indoor Season information:

The 2011-2012 Indoor Season runs from **October 22, 2011** to **late March 2012** for children **born 1993 to 1998 inclusive**. You can expect a phone call from your coach the **week of October 16th**. The **windup tournament** is included within these dates and will take place in late March.

The games for all age groups **will all take place on Saturday**. The games are scheduled any time **between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM**. **All levels are** scheduled for one hour, two 25-minute halves separated by a 5-minute half time.

The schedule below provides a brief overview of the season:

Location of games - Soccer games will take place in the following location:

- **University of Regina Gyms (old gyms)**

Parking - There will be **free parking** at the University during the game interval. **Details are still to be determined** and will be communicated closer to the beginning of the season.



Equipment requirements – REZYSA will provide each participant with a jersey and socks. To participate children **must have shin guards** (which must be fully covered by socks or sweatpants), a REZYSA jersey and indoor **non-marking running shoes**. **Jeans, jean shorts, or any bottoms with belt loops are prohibited and will not be permitted.** The jersey and socks are for each player to keep after the completion of the season.

Jewelry policy – To maintain the safety of all REZYSA Soccer participants, REZYSA has a strict no jewelry rule – **absolutely NO JEWELRY is permitted – taping is not an acceptable option. If the jewelry can't come off or the piercing can't come out – the child CANNOT play.**

Fees – All divisions receive jersey and socks. Fees cover costs in a number of areas including on-line registration, security, equipment and facilities. REZYSA is operated strictly on a cost recovery basis and the REZYSA Executive carefully manage costs to avoid increases where possible since it is our mandate to provide high quality, affordable, recreational soccer for your children.

Coaches and Assistant Coaches – REZYSA never has enough coaches. Coaches are integral to the success of your child's season. No experience is necessary. As in the past, REZYSA has arranged pre-season clinics for coaches from experienced soccer instructors. These are free clinics open to all coaches, assistant coaches and interested parents. Referees – The referees are an integral part of our sport and must be treated with respect at all times. All of our Referees are young soccer players who are still learning and trying to the best of their ability. Please treat them the way you would like your own child to be treated when developing their skills at their first job. If you have either praise or a concern with the referee from a game, please email the specific information to refs@rezysa.com. **Abuse of referees by coaches, players, parents or spectators will not be tolerated.**

Sportsmanship– Above all, remember that REZYSA is recreational soccer, **children are playing soccer to have fun!** The coaches strive for equal playing time and the children must be allowed to learn and play the game in a supportive atmosphere.
